When I first heard that the Oak Ridges Moraine Initiative was being acknowledged with provincial funding, I could not help but feel a sense of pride that I had played even a small part in this turn of events. For the past 3 years I have studied, fund-raised and lobbied on behalf of the moraine while completing my Bachelor of Environmental Studies at York University, specializing in **Environmental Management**. I would love to continue to be a part of the efforts to promote the protection of this environmentally sensitive area as a **Field Coordinator** with the Oak Ridges Moraine Initiative.

As an Environmental Officer with the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority last summer, I performed many of the functions of a field coordinator and managed all of the logistical details of the Humber River Green Infrastructure Project. In this role, I demonstrated what my supervisor called “**an uncanny ability to plan ahead and build collaborative relationships**” by accurately assessing supply needs, negotiating favourable payment and delivery terms, liaising with community and government partners, and even involving the press prior to the project launch so to ensure accurate and thorough press coverage of the project.
